

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 44 N., R. 60 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

From this corner, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 16, monumented with a basalt stone, 14x10x6 ins., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face, firmly set in the ground, with a scattered mound of stone W. of cor., bears S. $0^{\circ} 24'$ E., 39.64 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lines surveyed in this township are about 6,200 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy loam along Camp Creek to rocky clay on the benches. The entire area is used for grazing. No mining activity was noted.
