CHAINS	<p>The geographic position for the southeast corner of sec. 12, T. 32 N., R. 34 E. is at latitude 40° 38' 46.0" N. and longitude 118° 05' 03.4" W., as calculated from the Nevada Planning Division of the Nevada Highway Department triangulation station "BOARD," identical with the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 12 and 13, T. 32 N., R. 34 E., dependently resurveyed under Group No. 442 in 1967.</p> <p>The magnetic declination was found to be 18° E.</p>

	<p>The standard cor. of secs. 33 and 34, monumented with the original limestone, 22x12x10 ins., plainly mkd. with SC on the N. face and 3 notches on the E. and W. edges, firmly set in a mound of stone.</p>
