S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1863.</div> <div>From the cor. of Tps. 32 and 33 N., Rs. 34 and 34½ E., identical with the Nevada Planning Division of the Nevada Highway Department station "WIRE," monumented with a copper-coated steel stake, ½ in. diam., set 18 ins. below the surface of the ground, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div>T33N R34E R34½E S 36 S 36 S 1 S 1 T32N</div> <div>1967</div> <div>S. 89° 44' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.</div> <div>Over nearly level land, through shadscale and budsage.</div> <div>1.40 Fence, bears N. 74 3/4° E. and S. 74 3/4° W.</div> <div>2.70 Frontage road, parallels fence.</div> <div>6.00 Telephone line, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.</div> <div>19.60 Power line, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.</div> <div>40.14 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, monumented with the original redwood post, 2x2x36 ins. long, mkd. ¼ on the N. face, loosely set in a mound of earth.</div> <div>At the corner point</div> <div>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div>T33N R34E S 36 ¼ S 1</div> <div>1972</div> <div>reset the redwood post and set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</div> <div>S. 89° 46' W., beginning new measurement.</div> <div>Over nearly level land, through shadscale and budsage.</div> <div>4.60 Trail road, bears NNW. and SSE.</div>
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
