35.40	Draw, drains SE.; asc. 80 ft. over SW. slope.
40.00	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on solid rock over a cross (X) and in a mound of stone, 6 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
