CHAINS	
4.60	Ditch, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course S. 10° W.
7.50	Fence, bears S. 30° E. and N. 30° W.; enter sagebrush.
12.20	Ditch, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S. 20° E.; asc. 110 ft. over NE. slope to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
27.30	Draw, drains NE.
40.03	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. 4.50	Ditch, 3 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course SSE.
12.10	Fork of Smoke Creek, 10 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, course SE.
15.10	Fork of Smoke Creek, 10 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, course SSE.
31.60	Ditch, 20 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course SE.; enter rolling land, covered with sagebrush.
