GENERAL DESCRIPTION	
<p>The area surveyed within Township 31 North, Range 18 East, ranges from about 4,800 to 5,500 ft. above sea level, and is mostly mountainous. The soil consists of broken lava outcroppings to sandy clay loam. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and bunchgrass.</p>	
<p>The area is drained by Smoke Creek from the north and Rush Creek from the west.</p>	
<p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and sportsmen. Access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads leading from the Smoke Creek Road which enters the township in sec. 15 and leaves in sec. 18.</p>
