The soil consists of broken lava outcroppings to sandy clay loam. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and bunchgrass.</p> <p>The township is drained by Smoke Creek and Chimney Creek.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and sportsmen. The Smoke Creek Ranch is located in sec. 31. Access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads, leading from the Smoke Creek Road, which enters the township in sec. 31.</p>
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
