Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
C. F. Putnam and J. A. Benson, U. S. Deputy Surveyors,
in 1880

The cor. of Tps. 32 and 33 N., R. 18 E., monumented with a granite stone, 12x10x8 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 6 grooves on the N., S., E. and W. faces. This corner will now refer to Tps. 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 33 N., R. 18 E. only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to cap, with brass cap mkd.

Over mountainous land, covered with sagebrush and bunchgrass; asc. 360 ft. over broken NE. slope.

38.80 Spur, slopes N.; desc. slightly over NW. slope.

41.08 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, monumented with an iron stone, 8x8x6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. face. This corner will now refer to sec. 36 only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
