Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and bunchgrass.

Over mountainous land, covered with sagebrush and bunchgrass; asc. 40 ft. over SE. slope.

9.00 Ridge, bears NNE. and SSW.; asc. slightly along W. slope of ridge.

40.23 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a scoria stone, 24x14x12 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. ¼ on the W. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
