## TOWNSHIP 23 NORTH, RANGE 52 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

The geographic position of the southeast corner of the township is at latitude  $39^{\circ} 49' 21.913''$  N. and longitude  $116^{\circ} 03' 08.823''$  W., as shown on Nevada Protraction Diagram No. 165 and calculated under Group No. 389.

The mean magnetic declination was found to be  $17 1/2^{\circ}$  east.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY,  
T. 23 N., R. 52 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by

The cor. of Tps. 22 and 23 N., Rs. 52 and 53 E., monumented with the original wooden post,  $4 \times 4 \times 48$  ins. long, plainly mkd. with 1 notch on the N. edge, 2 notches on the E. edge, 2 notches on the W. edge, and T22N on one face and firmly set in a mound of stone, with a steel fence post alongside. This corner was tied in by Tellurometer traverse under Group No. 389 and shown on Protraction Diagram No. 164.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

reset the wooden post and the steel fence post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

40.20 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented with the decayed remains of an unmarked wooden post, loosely set in a mound of earth. This is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
