From this corner, the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 24 N.,  
R. 52 E., bears S.  $88^{\circ} 53'$  W., 9.82 chs. dist., monumented  
with an iron post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set in a mound  
of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. as  
described in the field notes of the resurvey of the  
S. bdy. of T. 24 N., R. 52 E., executed concurrently  
under this same group.

The point for the N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 6, is at propor-  
tionate distance and on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

with a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.,  
with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of  
the resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 24 N., R. 52 E.,  
executed concurrently under this same group.
