CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 23 North, Range 52 East ranges from about 5,800 to 7,700 ft. above sea level. The eastern portion is rolling to nearly level land. The central portion is mountainous and is called the Sulphur Spring Range. The western portion is rolling land. The soil consists of sandy clay. The vegetation consists of juniper, pinon, sagebrush and cultivated fields.

Henderson Creek crosses the western part of the township, draining \mathbb{N} . There are numerous seep springs in the lower elevations.

Romano Ranch is located in section 13. The principal users of the township are cattlemen. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

State Highway No. 51 crosses the western part of the town-ship in a N. and S. direction. A dismantled railroad roughly parallels the State Highway. A gravel road crosses the eastern part of the township in a N. and S. direction. Further access in the township is provided by bladed and trail roads.
