CHAINS	30.18	The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 23 N., R. 52 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the subdivisional lines of T. 23 N., R. 52 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.
	38.57	<p>The cor. of Tps. 23 and 24 N., Rs. 51 and 52 E., monumented with a wooden post, 4x4x36 ins. long, mkd. with illegible scribing and firmly set in a mound of stone, with a steel fence post alongside. This point is so near record position in relation to the well mkd. ¼ sec. cor. one-half mile to the east, that it is accepted as the original corner although the record reports a stone was set at this township corner. This cor. now refers to Tps. 24 N., Rs. 51 and 52 E. only.
