The area is nearly level to rolling and is located on the east slope of the Sulphur Spring Range. The soil is sandy clay. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and rabbitbrush in the lower elevations, and juniper and pinon timber in the higher elevations.</p> <p>ShIPLEY Hot Springs is located in section 23. There are numerous seep springs located in the lower elevations.</p> <p>The Sadler Ranch is located in section 23 and the Bailey Ranch is located in section 36. The principal users of the area are cattlemen. No mineral formations of consequence were noted.</p> <p>Access to the area is provided by a well maintained gravel road and several trail roads.</p>
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
