

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 24 N., R. 53 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed in Township 24 North, Range 53 East, is all nearly level land. The elevation is nearly the same throughout the township and is about 5,770 ft. above sea level. Most of the area resurveyed is in an alkali flat. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood, rabbitbrush and meadow grass.

Access to the township is by gravel road in the east tier of sections in Township 24 North, Range 52 East. Principal users of the township are farmers and cattlemen.

Brown's ranch house is in section 6. There are numerous springs in sections 6 and 7. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
