From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a rebar, with metal tag mkd. L.S. 451 attached, with a wooden post, 3x3x72 ins. long, plainly mkd. with 6 grooves on the N. face and 5 grooves on the E. face, loosely set alongside. The rebar is set in a fence extending E. and W. This is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Point for the ½ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
