T23N R51E S 36 1972 reset the steel fence post alongside the iron post. N. 0° 25' W., along the E. bdy. of sec. 36. Over rolling land, through sagebrush; desc. 90 ft. over a broken E. slope. 19.00 Draw, drains NE.; asc. over a SE. slope. Spur, slopes ENE.; trail road, bears ENE. and WSW.; 22.50 desc. 130 ft. over a NNW. slope to the \frac{1}{4} sec. cor. The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented with the 40.27 original wooden post, 4x4x24 ins. long, mkd. with illegible scribing and loosely set in a mound of earth.
