From this corner, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 34, T. 24 N., R. 51 E., bears N. $89^{\circ} 30'$ W., 3.195 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 24 N., R. 51 E., executed concurrently under this same group.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed in Township 23 North, Range 51 East, ranges from about 6,300 to 7,800 ft. above sea level. The area is rolling and mountainous. The soil is sandy in the lower elevations and rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush in the lower elevations and juniper and pinon in the higher elevations.

The area is drained principally by Henderson Creek, Vinini Creek and Frazier Creek which flow in a general E. direction.

An abandoned house is located in sec. 24. An abandoned mining operation is located in sec. 1. No other mining activity of consequence was noted.

Access in the area is provided by gravel and bladed roads and a few trail roads.
