	<p>From the cor. of Tps. 24 N., Rs. 51 and 52 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with a steel fence post alongside, with a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the south bdy. of T. 24 N., R. 52 E., executed concurrently under this same group.</p> <p>N. 89° 22' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 36.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through sagebrush; desc. 40 ft. over a W. slope.</p>
8.70	State Highway No. 51, bears S. 5½° E. and N. 5½° W.
22.30	Henderson Creek, 5 lks. wide, ½ ft. deep, course N. in bottom of wash, 40 lks. wide, 15 ft. deep.
23.20	Dismantled railroad, bears N. and S.; asc. 30 ft. over a gradual E. slope.
40.08	<p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, monumented with the original wooden post, 2½x2½x24 ins. long, mkd. with illegible scribing and loosely set in a mound of earth. This corner now refers to sec. 36, T. 24 N., R. 51 E. only.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T24N R51E ¼ S 36</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1972</p> <p>reset the wooden post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.</p> <hr style="width: 20%; margin: 10px auto;"/> <p>N. 89° 39' W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, through sagebrush; asc. 60 ft. over an E. slope to the closing corner.</p>
32.60	Trail road, bears SSE. and NW.
35.80	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains irregularly NE.
36.21	The closing corner of Tps. 23 N., Rs. 51 and 52 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with a steel fence post alongside, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 23 N., R. 51 E., executed concurrently under this same group.
