Undergrowth, native grasses.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land within Township 24 North, Range 23 East, ranges from about 3,820 to 3,840 ft. above sea level and is located in the dry lake bed of Winnemucca Lake. The soil is of a sandy clay loam.</p> <p>The lake bed at one time was fed with water from Pyramid Lake to the West; however, as the water table dropped in Pyramid Lake, Winnemucca Lake became dry.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by State Highway No. 34, and numerous trail roads.</p> <hr/>
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
