N. 2° 30' E., bet. secs. 31 and 36.</p> <p>Over mountainous land, through dense juniper and pinon, with medium sagebrush.</p> <p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T13N R21E R22E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 S 31 1973</p> <p>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>Descend 60 ft. over broken N. slope.</p> |

| 76.50 | Spur, slopes SE.; asc. gradually along broken E. slope. |
