

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 13 N., R. 21 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 13 North, Range 21 East is located about 4 miles NE. of Gardnerville, Nevada. The elevation ranges from about 5,000 to 7,000 ft. above sea level. The eastern portion of the township is mountainous and the western portion is rolling foothills. The soil varies from sandy loam to rocky clay. The vegetation consists of scattered to dense juniper and pinon, with medium sagebrush and various grasses.

Buckeye Creek, an intermittent stream, flows westerly through the center of the township. There were no other natural sources of water noted in the area. An abandoned BLM stock well is located in section 19, another in section 15 and an operating BLM stock well is located in section 28. Sections 29, 32 and 33 contain several farms that are under cultivation and obtain water from private wells.

There are several graded roads and numerous trail roads that provide access to the area. A major powerline crosses the NW. portion of the township.

The area is used principally for grazing purposes. There are numerous abandoned mines in the SE. portion of the township but no mining activity of consequence was noted during the survey.
