A pinon, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 43° E.,  
106 lks. dist., mkd. T12N R21E S32 BT.

A juniper, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 79° E.,  
124 lks. dist., mkd. T11N R21E S5 BT.

A juniper, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 35° W.,  
151 lks. dist., mkd. T11N R21E S6 BT.

A juniper, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 13° W.,  
57 lks. dist., mkd. T12N R21E S31 BT.

From this cor., Nevada Highway Department marker, monu-  
mented with a copper disk in concrete, set flush with the  
ground, bears N. 36° 21' W., 10.84 chs. dist., with top  
mkd. 048 DOK.

deposit the original corner stone alongside the iron  
post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high,  
W. of cor.

N. 89° 39' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over rolling land, covered with medium juniper, pinon  
and sagebrush.

13.60 Wash, 50 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains WSW.

34.40 Trail road, bears N. and S.

38.30 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at propor-  
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the  
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
