CHAINS	<div><div><div>T 12 N R 29 E</div><div>S 18 S 17</div><div>S 19 S 20</div><div>1973</div></div><p>Deposit the mkd. stone, the remains of the wooden post, and the iron rod alongside the iron post.</p><p>S. 0° 03' E., on record bearing bet. secs. 19 and 20.</p><p>Over nearly level land, through scattering undergrowth.</p><div>7.05 Telephone line, 14 strand, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.</div><div>12.15 Point for the meander cor. of secs. 19 and 20, at record dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.</div><p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p><div><div><div>T 12 N R 29 E</div><div>S 19 S 20</div><div></div><div>MC</div><div>TR-37</div><div>1973</div></div></div></div>

	<p>From the meander cor. of secs. 19 and 20, hereinbefore described.</p> <p>Thence westerly with the adjusted original meanders of sec. 19, identical with the bdy. bet. sec. 19 and Tract No. 37. The angle pts. are not permanently monumented.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through scattering shadscale.</p> <div><div>S. 84° 30' W.,</div><div>At 16.80 chs. on this course, an old, fallen fence line, bears N. and S.</div><div>At 32.18 chs. on this same course, intersect the thalweg of the Walker River; point for the NW. cor. of Tract No. 37, identical with Angle Pt. No. 1 of Tract No. 38, falls in the river and is impracticable to monument.</div><div>Continue with the adjusted original meanders, now identical with the bdy. bet. sec. 19 and Tract No. 38.</div></div>
