CHAINS

Seat a brass tablet, $3\frac{1}{2}$ in. stem, $2\frac{1}{4}$ in. diam., in the top of a cement filled stovepipe, 6 ins. diam., 36 ins. long, set 30 ins. in the ground, with brass tablet mkd.

Continue over nearly level land.

Desc. over steep bank, 8 ft. high, bears N. 27° W. and S. 15° E.

40.86 Intersect the thalweg of the Walker River. Point for Angle Pt. No. 5 of Tract No. 40, identical with the NE. cor. of Tract No. 39, T. 11 N., R. 29 E., falls in the river and is impracticable to monument.

From this point the point for the SW. cor. of Tract No. 37, identical with the NW. cor. of Tract No. 38, T. 11 N., R. 29 E., bears N. 16° 52' W., 0.49 chs. dist.

Land, gentle ESE. slope to level bottom land. Soil, sand and gravel on slope, alkaline silt in bottom. Vegetation, shadscale and sage on slope, with dense tamarisk and willow in bottom.

From the meander cor. of secs. 5 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with the rusted off stub of an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, protruding 1 in. above ground, with the upper portion lying alongside with the brass cap mkd. as described in the 1918 official record.

This cor. now also becomes the SE. cor. of Tract No. 37, and the NE. cor. of Tract No. 38, T. 11 N., R. 29 E.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit the remains of the original iron post alongside the new iron post.

West, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., identical with the S. bdy. of Tract No. 37, and the N. bdy. of Tract No. 38, T. 11 N., R. 29 E., on a transit line describing the tangent which bears West.

Desc. across former lake bed over a sand and gravel covered W. slope.

28.00 Bottom of descent, slopes NW.; asc. over slight NE. slope.
