


Survey, Portions, S. Bdy.,
T. 12 N., R. 29 E., Mt. Diablo Mer., Nevada

CHAINS



Continue over level land on a transit line describing the tangent which bears S. 89° 58.6' W.

- 160.40 Begin descent over river bank.
- 161.00 Bottom of bank, bears N. 15° W. and S. 20° E.; continue crossing sand bar.
- 163.23 Intersect the thalweg of the Walker River. Point for the SW. cor. of Tract No. 37, and the NW. cor. of Tract No. 38, T. 11 N., R. 29 E., North 3 lks. from the tangent. Point falls in the river and is impracticable to monument.

From this point the point for Angle Pt. No. 5 of Tract No. 40, identical with the NE. cor. of Tract 39, T. 11 N., R. 29 E., bears S. 16° 52' E., 0.49 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.

Land, gentle W. to NW. slope, changing to level bottom land.
Soil, sand and gravel on the slope, alkaline silt in bottom.
Vegetation, shadscale and sage on the slope, with dense tamarisk and willow in bottom.

Survey of Tract No. 38,
T. 12 N., R. 29 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada

Beginning at Angle Pt. No. 1, Tract No. 38, identical with the point of intersection of the adjusted original meanders of sec. 19 with the thalweg of the Walker River, and the NW. cor. of Tract No. 37, hereinbefore described.

The bdy. bet. sec. 19 and Tract No. 38 is identical with that portion of the adjusted original meanders of sec. 19, W. of the thalweg of the Walker River, hereinbefore described.

Angle Pt. No. 2 of Tract No. 38 is identical with the meander cor. of secs. 19 and 24 on the W. bdy. of the Tp., and Angle Pt. No. 1 of Tract No. 37, T. 12 N., R. 28 E., described in the field notes of the survey of a portion of the E. bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 28 E., of this assignment.

S. 0° 05' W., on line 2 - 3 of Tract No. 38, identical with line 1 - 3 of Tract No. 37, T. 12 N., R. 28 E., described in the field notes of the survey of a portion of the E. bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 28 E., of this assignment.

Over nearly level former lake bed.

- 134.36 Angle Pt. No. 3 of Tract No. 38, identical with Angle Pt. No. 2 of Tract No. 39, and with Angle Pts. No. 3 of Tract No. 37 and No. 1 of Tract No. 38, T. 12 N., R. 28 E., described in the field notes of the survey of a portion of the E. bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 28 E., of this assignment.
