



Survey of Tract No. 38,
T. 12 N., R. 29 E., Mt. Diablo Mer., Nevada

CHAINS	
	S. 67° 40' E., on line 3 - 4 of Tract No. 38, identical with line 2 - 1 of Tract No. 39.
	Over the nearly level former bed of Walker Lake.
8.50	U.S. Highway No. 95, paved, 50 lks. wide, bears N. 24° W. and S. 24° E.
9.30	Fence, 4 strand barbed wire, bears N. 24° W. and S. 24° E.
11.00	Drainage ditch, 15 lks. wide, drains S. 26° E.
29.72	Point selected for a witness point. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. <div>WP T 12 N R 29 E TR-38  TR-39 1973</div>
34.00	Enter dense tamarisk and willow undergrowth, edge bears N. and S.
48.08	Point selected for a witness cor. to Angle Pt. No. 4 of Tract No. 38, identical with Angle Pt. No. 1 of Tract No. 39. Seat a brass tablet, 3½ in. stem, 2¼ ins. diam., in the top of a cement filled stovepipe, 6 ins. diam., 36 ins. long, set 30 ins. in the ground, with brass tablet mkd. <div>WC T 12 N R 29 E TR-38 AP-4  AP-1 TR-39 TR-37 1973</div>
	Continue over level bottom land.
48.30	Top of vertical bank, 8 ft. high, extends N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.; continue crossing river bottom.
48.38	Intersect the thalweg of the Walker River. Point for Angle Pt. No. 4 of Tract No. 38, identical with Angle Pt. No. 1 of Tract No. 39, on the W. bdy. of Tract No. 37, falls in the river and is impractical to monument. Land, nearly level. Soil, sand and gravel. Vegetation, shadscale, tamarisk, and willow.
	The E. bdy. of Tract No. 38 is identical with a portion of the W. bdy. of Tract No. 37, and a portion of the thalweg of the Walker River, hereinafter described.
