49.30	Drainage ditch, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains S. 26° E.
52.00	From this point an iron rod, not of known record, 1 in. diam., firmly set, protruding 4 ins. above ground, bears W., 0.03 chs. dist.
99.00	Drainage ditch, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S. 45° E.
101.60	Fence, 3 strand barbed wire, bears N. 84° E. and S. 84° W.
108.30	Road, unimproved dirt, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 80° E. and W. on a curve.
113.20	Drainage ditch, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S. 64° E.
121.20	Drainage ditch, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course N. 65° E.
121.70	Wash, 20 lks. wide, drains N. 65° E.
131.20	Drainage ditch, 3 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course E.
132.03	From this point an iron rod, not of known record, 1 in. diam., firmly set, protruding 8 ins. above ground, bears W., 0.023 chs. dist.
149.70	Drainage ditch, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S. 40° E. from W.
154.00	Drainage ditch, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S. 70° E.
162.00	Drainage ditch, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S. 80° E.
163.34	The meander cor. of secs. 19 and 24, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., identical with Angle Pt. No. 1 of Tract No. 37, and Angle Pt. No. 2 of Tract No. 38, T. 12 N., R. 29 E., hereinbefore described. Land, level. Soil, alkaline silt. Vegetation, grass and scattered tamarisk.
Subdivision of Section 25, T. 12 N., R. 28 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada	
	From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36. N. 0° 24' E., on the N. and S. center line of sec. 25. Asc. over steep, rocky SE. slope, through scattering undergrowth.
10.70	Ridge, bears N. 50° E. and S. 30° W.; desc. over steep, rocky N. slope.
16.10	Ravine, 10 lks. wide, drains N. 70° E.; asc. over S. slope.
17.70	Spur, slopes E.; desc. over N. slope.
19.20	Ravine, 5 lks. wide, drains E.; asc. over S. slope.
20.005	Point for the center S. $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of sec. 25. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
