Secs. 32 and 35, T. 11 N., R. 29 E., Mt. Diablo Mer., Nevada

CHAINS

Tract No. 37. (The angle pts. are not permanently monumented.)

Over nearly level land with rolling sand dunes and gravel flats.

N. 12° 27' W., 4.99 chs., Angle Pt. No. 5

N. 12° 12' W., 34.96 chs., Angle Pt. No. 6

N. 12° 58' W., At 1.50 chs. on this course,
a fallen fence, barbed wire,
extends E. and W.

42.25 chs. The meander cor. of secs. 26
and 35, identical with
Angle Pt. No. 1 of Tract
No. 37, and the southeasterly
cor. of Tract No. 38, herein-
before described.

Land, nearly level; rolling sand dunes, and gravel flats.
Soil, sand and gravel.

Vegetation, scattering shadscale and sagebrush.

From the stan. meander cor. of sec. 32, on the 2nd Stan.
Par. N., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam.,
firmly set, top flush with a concrete base, 12 ins. square,
protruding 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.
