	<p>Thence southerly, on line 2-3 of Tract No. 37, identical with a portion of the new meanders of Walker Lake.</p> <p>Along a sandy, gravelly lake shore, following the water's edge.</p> <p>S. 37° 52' E., 8.06 chs. S. 24° 30' E., 41.08 chs. S. 18° 20' E., 38.42 chs. Angle Pt. No. 3 of Tract No. 37, identical with a meander cor. on the 2nd Standard Par. N., hereinbefore described.</p>
	<p>Line 3-4 of Tract No. 37 is identical with that portion of the 2nd Stan. Par. N., east of Walker Lake, hereinbefore described.</p>
	<p>The bdy. bet. sec. 35 and Tract No. 37 is identical with the adjusted original meanders of sec. 35, hereinbefore described.</p>
	<div><div>Survey of Tract No. 40, T. 11 N., R. 29 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada</div><p>Beginning at Angle Pt. No. 1 of Tract No. 40, which is a meander cor. bet. Tract No. 39 and Tract No. 40 on the water's edge on the W. side of Walker Lake.</p><p>Seat a brass tablet, 3½ in. stem, 2¼ in diam., in cement, in a drill hole in bedrock, with brass tablet mkd.</p><div><div>T 11 N R 29 E</div><div>TR-39 MC</div><div>AP-1</div><div>TR-40</div><div>1973</div></div><p>West, on line 1-2 of Tract No. 40, identical with the S. bdy. of Tract No. 39, crossing the former bed of Walker Lake.</p><p>4.42 Angle Pt. No. 2 of Tract No. 40, identical with the original meander cor. of secs. 32 and 33, and the south-westerly cor. of Tract No. 39, hereinbefore described.</p></div>
