	<p>Set a steel fence post, 5-1/2 ft. long, alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top. Cor. falls in the head of a ravine, drains N. 65° W.; asc. 140 ft. over NW. slope.</p>	
51.10	<p>Spur, slopes N. 25° W.; asc. 110 ft. over WNW. slope.</p>	
59.10	<p>Ridge, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.; desc. 170 ft. over ENE. slope.</p>	
69.20	<p>Ravine, drains N. 5° E.; asc. 10 ft. over WNW. slope.</p>	
71.60	<p>Spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 10 ft. over ENE. slope.</p>	
72.60	<p>Ravine, drains N. 15° W.; asc. 120 ft. over WNW. slope.</p>

	<p>Set a steel fence post, 5-1/2 ft. long, alongside the iron post.</p>	
	<p>From this corner, the cor. of secs. 30 and 31, on the West bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 34 E., monumented with an iron post, 2-1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, exposed 10 ins. above the ground and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 32 N., R. 34 E., bears S. 1° 34' W., 4.74 chs. dist.</p>	
	<p>From this same corner, the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 30, on the W. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 34 E., monumented with an iron post, 2-1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, exposed 6 ins. above ground, mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 32 N., R. 34 E., bears N. 1° 34' E., 35.52 chs. dist.; raise a mound of stone, 3-1/2 ft. base, 2-1/2 ft. high, E. of cor.</p>	
	<p>From this same corner, the A.M., monumented with an iron post, 2-1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, exposed 12 ins. above ground and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 32 N., R. 34 E., bears N. 89° 34' E., 1.71 chs. dist.</p>
