	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed in Township 16 North, Range 64 East, is situated about 2 miles southeast of East Ely, Nevada. The elevation varies from 6,400 to 7,500 ft. above sea level. The vegetation consists of juniper timber, sagebrush, shadscale and budsage.</p> <p>The Northern Nevada Railroad enters the township on the W. bdy. of section 7 and leaves the township on the N. bdy. of section 6. A double pole and a single pole powerline enters the township on the S. bdy. of section 33 and leaves the township on the N. bdy. of section 5. There are numerous trail roads throughout the township.</p> <p>A well is located in section 6. The general drainage throughout the township is westerly. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
