	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	<p>The area resurveyed in Township 17 North, Range 64 East, is situated about 2 miles south of McGill, Nevada. The terrain is mountainous on the eastern half and rolling to nearly level in the western half of the township. The elevation ranges from about 6,100 to 9,200 ft. above sea level. The general drainage is westerly. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood, whitesage, rabbitbrush, bunchgrass and native grass. There are pinon, juniper and mahogany on the Duck Creek Range of mountains which crosses the middle of the township in a northerly direction.</p> <p>There are two Nevada Northern Railroads which enter the township on the south boundary and leaves the township on the north boundary. U. S. Highway No. 93 and Alternate U. S. Highway No. 50 enters on the west boundary of sec. 30 and leaves on the north boundary of sec. 5. Further access to the township is provided by numerous, secondary and trail roads. There are numerous powerlines and telephone lines throughout the western portion of the township.</p> <p>There is cultivated land in sections 5 and 6, and a house located in sec. 5. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
