- 6.98 The corner of secs. 6 and 31, Tps. 1½ and 2 N., R. 69 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., as described in the field notes of T. 2 N., R. 69 E., concurrently resurveyed under this same group.

Land, rolling.  
Soil, sandy clay.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush.  
Timber, juniper and pinon.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, Tps. 1½ and 2 N., R. 69 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., as described in the field notes of T. 2 N., R. 69 E., concurrently resurveyed under this same group.

SOUTH, bet. secs. 3 and 4.

- 8.64 Intersect the N. bdy. of sec. 4, T. 1 N., R. 69 E.  
Point for the closing corner of secs. 3 and 4, T. 1½ N., R. 69 E.  
Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
