From this corner, the N. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 1 N., R. 69 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., as described in the field notes of the resurvey of T. 1 N., R. 69 E., resurveyed under Group No. 511, bears S. 89° 36' E., 2.89 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the cor. of Tps. 1 and 1½ N., Rs. 68 and 69 E., hereinbefore described, bears N. 89° 36' W., 36.21 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land surveyed in Township 1½ North, Range 69 East, ranges from about 5,600 to 5,750 ft. above sea level and is rolling land. The soil varies from sandy clay to rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, native grasses and the timber is juniper and pinon.

The principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by trail roads. No mineral formations of any consequence were noted during the survey.
