

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 69 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, the Special Instructions dated May 25, 1973, and supplemental Special Instructions dated March 28, 1975.

The geographic position for the southeast corner of the township is at latitude $37^{\circ} 58' 51''$ N. and longitude $114^{\circ} 11' 24''$ W., as calculated along section lines from triangulation station "FOGLIANI," located in sec. 32, T. 3 N., R. 70 E.

The magnetic declination was read at a number of stations throughout the township and the mean of these readings was found to be $15\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ east.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound of stone, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, monumented with a basalt stone, 16x10x8 ins., plainly mkd. with 2 grooves on E. face and 4 grooves on W. face, firmly set 8 ins. in the ground, bears N. $89^{\circ} 44'$ E., 0.59 chs. dist., add the marks AM and bury the cornerstone 4 ins. below the surface of the ground, from which the only remaining bearing tree mkd. in 1902.

A juniper, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 40° W., 19 lks. dist., with open blaze, scribe marks illegible. (Record N. 50° W., 18 lks.).

S. $89^{\circ} 44'$ W., bet. secs. 3 and 34.

Over mountainous land, through sagebrush and juniper trees; desc. 100 ft. over a SW. slope.
