

RETRACEMENT OF THE NEVADA-CALIFORNIA STATE LINE
BETWEEN MILE POST NOS. 120 AND 127

	<p>Mile Post No. 120, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the retracement of the 120th mile on the Nevada-California State Line and are included in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of T. 28 N., R. 18 E., executed under this same group.</p> <p>S. 0° 18' W., along the 121st mile.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush and greasewood.</p>
60.60	Fence, bears S. 81° E. and N. 81° W., 28 lks. dist. to fence cor., from which fences bear N., S., and S. 81° E.
61.50	Improved gravel road, on curve, bears N. 54½° W. and S. 81° E.
61.85	The closing corner of Tps. 27 and 28 N., R. 18 E., hereinafter described.
80.27	Mile Post No. 121, monumented with a granite stone, 8x8 ins. square, exposed 24 ins. above ground, mkd. with 121 on the N. face and NEV on the E. face. The monument is considered sound and well marked and does not require remonumentation.
	<p>S. 0° 13' W., along the 122nd mile.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush and greasewood; along E. side of fence.</p>
61.76	The closing corner of secs. 5 and 8, T. 27 N., R. 18 E., hereinafter described.
80.25	Point for Mile Post No. 122, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. NOT MONUMENTED.
	<p>S. 0° 22' W., along the 123rd mile.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, covered with medium greasewood; along E. side of fence.</p>
46.40	Corner of fences, bears W., 7 lks. dist., from which fences bear, N. 60¼° W., S. 60¼° E. and N.
46.60	Telephone line, parallels railroad tracks.
47.20	Trail road, parallels railroad tracks.
