| | CHAINS | <div data-bbox="666 376 971 405">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</div> <p data-bbox="391 440 1310 733">The land within Township 27 North, Range 18 East, ranges from about 4,000 to 5,000 ft. above sea level and is gently rolling to mountainous in the northeast portion of the township with the remaining terrain being nearly level. The soil varies from sandy clay and rocky in the higher elevations to sandy and sandy clay loam in the remaining area. The vegetation consists of mostly sagebrush and some greasewood in the higher elevation to mostly greasewood in the remaining area.</p> <p data-bbox="391 766 1279 989">The Western Pacific Railroad crosses the southern part of the township, entering on the east boundary of section 36 and exiting on the south boundary of section 33. The Southern Pacific Railroad crosses the central portion of the township, entering on the east boundary of section 25 and exiting on the west boundary of section 8.</p> <p data-bbox="391 1024 1279 1185">Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by an improved gravel road, which crosses the northeast and north portion of the township. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> | |
