S. Astronomer and Surveyor A. W. Von Schmidt, in 1872 and Retraced by U. S. Deputy Surveyor Milton Santee, in 1880.</div> <div>Mile Post No. 119, monumented with a basalt stone, 16x10x8 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with NEV on the E. face, CAL on the W. face, O 119 M on the N. face and 1872 L120 on the S. face.</div> <div>At the corner point</div> <div>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div>MP 119 CAL NEV </div> <div>1973</div> <div>deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 12 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</div> <div>S. 0° 18' W., along the 120th mile.</div> <div>Over rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush and greasewood.</div> <div>5.00 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains WSW.; desc. 210 ft. over S. slope to Mile Post No. 120.</div> <div>61.24 The closing corner of secs. 29 and 32, T. 28 N., R. 18 E., hereinafter described.</div> <div>71.00 Wash, 50 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains SSW.</div> <div>79.94 Mile Post No. 120, monumented with a granite stone, 20x20x20 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with NEV on the E. face, CAL on the W. face, ML20 on the N. face and 1872 L120 on the S. face.</div> <div>At the corner point</div> <div>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</div> |
