Deputy Surveyor Milton Santee, in 1880.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of Tps. 28 and 29 N., Rs. 18 and 19 E., monumented with a basalt stone, 16x14x14 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 6 grooves on the N., S., E. and W. faces.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> T29N R18E R19E S 36 S 31 S 1 S 6 T28N 1973 </div> <p>deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 22 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 5 ft. base, 3 ft. high, S. of cor.</p> <p>S. 89° 48' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush and greasewood.</p> <p>Ascend 150 ft. over gradual E. slope.</p> <p>17.60 Trail road, bears NW. and SE.</p> <p>31.50 Base of mountains, edge bears N. and S.; asc. 120 ft. over broken E. slope.</p> <p>39.42 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p>
