

RETRACEMENT OF THE NEVADA-CALIFORNIA STATE LINE  
BETWEEN MILE POST NOS. 107 AND 109

CHAINS	
	S. 0° 02' E., along the 109th mile.
	Over gently rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush and bunchgrass.
8.00	Trail road, bears NE. and SW.
10.70	Wash, 70 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SW.
36.51	The closing corner of Tps. 29 and 30 N., R. 18 E., hereinafter described.
58.20	Wash, 70 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains SSE.
72.00	Wash, 80 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SSW.
80.26	Mile Post No. 109, monumented with a volcanic stone, 15x8x6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 109 on the N. face, CAL on the W. face, NEV on the E. face and 1872 L 120 on the S. face.
	At the corner point
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 6 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

	Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor Milton Santee, in 1880.
	From the cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 N., Rs. 18 and 19 E., monumented with a volcanic stone, 18x12x10 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 6 grooves on the N., S., E. and W. faces.
	At the corner point
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 4 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
