Over rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush and bunchgrass; desc. 90 ft. over NW. slope changing to N. slope.

- 7.50 Draw, drains NE.
- 18.50 Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains E.; asc. 50 ft. over SE. slope.
- 35.00 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 20 ft. over N. slope.
- 39.17 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented with a volcanic stone, 26x12x10 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the W. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
