Transitman in 1917.</p> <hr/> <p>From the <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 18, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set and exposed 10 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the official record of the 1917 resurvey.</p> <p>N. 0° 16' W., bet. secs. 13 and 18.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush, greasewood and shadscale.</p> <p>3.40 Rock fence, bears NNW. and SSE.</p> <p>7.90 Trail road, bears NE. and SW.</p> <p>12.90 Ditch, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course NE.; enter cultivated land.</p> <p>16.00 Ditch, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course E.</p> <p>17.20 Ditch, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course NE.</p> <p>40.00 Ditch, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course NNE.</p> <p>40.23 Point for the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, <math>2\frac{1}{2}</math> ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>T37N R18E R19E <u>S 12   S 7</u> <u>S 13   S 18</u></p> <p>1973</p> </div> <p>set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 24 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 0° 16' W., bet. secs. 7 and 12.</p> <p>Over cultivated land.</p> <p>27.80 Trail road, bears E. and W.</p>
