Deputy Surveyor, in 1878</div> <div>From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div>T14N R69E S 2 S 1 S 35 S 36 T13N</div> <div>1921</div> <div>The brass cap is remarked to read as follows:</div> <div>T14N R69E S 35 S 36 S 2 S 1 T13N</div> <div>1973 1921</div> <div>N. 6° 48' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36.</div> <div>Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush, grease- wood and shadscale.</div> <div>20.40 Spur, slopes E.</div> <div>22.80 Trail road, bears E. and W.</div> <div>34.60 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains E.</div> <div>36.80 Trail road, bears E. and W.</div> <div>41.12 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with the original limestone, 14x8x8 ins., dimly mkd. ¼ on the W. face, firmly set in a mound of stone.</div> <div>At the corner point</div> <div>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</div> <div>T14N R69E ¼ S 35 S 36</div> <div>1973</div> <div>bury the marked stone alongside the iron post.</div>
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
