DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 14 N., R. 69 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed within Township 14 North, Range 69 East, is rolling land except for the bottom land along Weaver Creek. The soil is sandy, gravelly and rocky loam, covered with a medium growth of shadscale, greasewood and sagebrush. The soil along Weaver Creek is a light sandy loam.

Weaver Creek enters the area surveyed in section 15 and flows in an east-southeasterly direction through sections 13, 14, 15 and 24. Strawberry Creek enters the area surveyed in section 21 and flows in a north-northeasterly direction through sections 15, 16 and 21.

U.S. Highway Nos. 6 and 50 enters the area surveyed in section 24 and leaves in section 16. State Highway No. 73 enters the township in section 25 and junctions with U.S. Highway Nos. 6 and 50 in section 24. Further access in the area is provided by bladed and trail roads.

The principal users of the area are farmers.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during this survey.
