

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 14 N., R. 70 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	<p>The land encompassed in this resurvey is located about 2 miles north of the town of Baker, Nevada. The elevation is about 5,400 ft. above sea level throughout the township. The vegetation consists of greasewood, shadscale and sagebrush. There is cultivated land in the north-west portion of the township.</p> <p>Access to the township is by U. S. Highway Nos. 50 and 6, which crosses the township in an east-west direction and by Nevada Highway No. 73 which enters on the S. bdy. of sec. 32 and leaves the township on the W. bdy. of sec. 30. There are numerous unimproved or lightly gravelled roads throughout the township. There are numerous telephone and powerline throughout the township.</p> <p>Principal users of the township are farmers and ranchers. No mineral formation of consequence was noted during the survey.</p>
