

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,  
T. 23 N., R. 54 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	<p>The land within Township 23 North, Range 54 East, ranges from about 5,700 to 6,000 ft. above sea level. The east portion of the area surveyed is located at the foothills of the Diamond Mountains, the remainder is in Diamond Valley. The soil consists of sandy loam in the valley and a heavy clay with rock outcropping in the mountains. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood, shadscale, rabbitbrush and cultivated crops.</p> <p>The Thompson ranch house is located in sec. 3, the Hubbard trailer house is located in sec. 27, a farm equipment building is located in sec. 20, and a trailer house is located in sec. 32. Numerous springs and wells were noted and tied in throughout the township.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and farmers. Access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
