Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
U. S. Transitman C. F. Moore,  
in 1921.

The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the  
Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly  
set and exposed 16 ins. above ground, with brass cap  
mkd. as described in the official record of T. 25 N.,  
R. 54 E., executed under Group No. 94, in 1921. This  
corner will now refer to secs. 33 and 34 only; the brass  
cap is now mkd.

From this corner, the NE. cor. of sec. 4, T. 24 N.,  
R. 54 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam.,  
firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above ground, with brass  
cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 24 N.,  
R. 54 E., executed concurrently under this same group,  
bears N. 0° 01' W., 8.00 chs. dist.

From this same corner, the 1921 ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 4  
and 33, now an amended monument and hereinafter  
described, bears N. 89° 56' W., 16.30 chs. dist.
