Moore, in 1921.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.</p> <p>NORTH, bet. secs. 33 and 34.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through sagebrush; desc. 70 ft. over NW. slope, changing to W. slope.</p> <p>13.30 Ravine, from Box Spring Canyon, drains irregularly W.; asc. 390 ft. over S. slope.</p> <p>37.70 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 50 ft. over NW. slope.</p> <p>39.86 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set and exposed 12 ins. above a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the official record of T. 25 N., R. 54 E., executed under Group No. 94, in 1921.</p> <p>Add marks for T. 25 N., R. 54 E.; the brass cap is now mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> $\frac{1}{4}$ T25N R54E S 33 S 34 1974 1921 </div> <p>rebuild the supporting mound of stone, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base to top, around the iron post.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 0° 11' E., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over mountainous land, through scattered juniper, pinon and sagebrush; desc. 150 ft. over NW. slope.</p> <p>4.60 Draw, drains W.; asc. 320 ft. over SW. slope.</p> <p>20.50 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 110 ft. over NW. slope.</p> <p>26.50 Draw, drains W.; asc. 210 ft. over SW. slope.</p> <p>38.00 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 30 ft. over NW. slope.</p> <p>40.02 The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., loosely set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the official record of T. 25 N., R. 54 E., executed under Group No. 94, in 1921.</p>
