T. 15 N., R. 41 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, Nevada

CHAINS	
	Descend over broken SW. slope, through sagebrush, changing to pasture grass.
9.00	Barbed wire fence, 4 strands, bears N. 26° E. and S. 26° W.
13.70	Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears S. 2° E. and N. 13° W.
23.80	Small bluff, edge bears NE. and SW.; continue to descend over broken SW. slope.
27.40	Irrigation ditch, 3 lks. wide, drains N.
31.70	Reese River, 20 lks. wide, course N.; ascend over gentle SE. slope.
36.30	Barbed wire fence, 4 strands, bears S. 8° W. and N. 10° W.
39.40	Ditch, 5 lks. wide, drains N. 32° E.
39.98	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 28 and 33, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, supported in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

	Continue to ascend over gentle SE. slope.
52.40	Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 14° E. and S. 14° W.
56.70	Ditch, 5 lks. wide, drains N. 14° E.
57.20	Barbed wire fence, 4 strands, bears N. 14° E. and S. 14° W.
64.10	Telephone and telegraph lines, bear N. 32° E. and S. 32° W.
65.20	Enter marsh land, edge bears N. 45° E. and S. 45° W.
69.80	Leave marsh land, edge bears N. 45° E. and S. 45° W.
72.90	Barbed wire fence, 4 strands, bears N. 8° E. and S. 32° W.
74.80	Nevada State Highway No. 21, dirt road, 40 lks. wide, bears N. 28° E. and S. 32° W.
79.70	Ditch, 4 lks. wide, drains S.
79.96	The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33. Land, gently rolling pasture land. Soil, rocky sandy loam. Undergrowth, sagebrush and pasture grass.
	Subdivision of Section 33, T. 15 N., R. 41 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, Nevada
	From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, on the S. Bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd., and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 14 N., R. 41 E., executed concurrently under this same group.
